Free* ACTH tests extended until 31st December



The 'Talk About Laminitis' scheme that provides free laboratory tests for Cushing's Disease (ACTH) has been extended until the end of the year, so if you have any concerns that your horse or pony might being showing signs of Cushing's (curly coat, patchy sweating, recurrent infections, laminitis, drinking excessively etc) there's still time to book in with the office. It is the laboratory fee for testing the ACTH levels that is offered free of charge – there is still a fee for any visit and for taking and reporting the blood sample.
